

10 DAY CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

UTILITY RELOCATION FOR THE UNION SQUARE/MARKET STREET STATION
CONSTRUCTION ON STOCKTON BETWEEN O'FARRELL AND MARKET
STREETS WILL BEGIN JANUARY 2, 2012
CONTRACT NUMBER 1251

Project Description

The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) and Synergy Project Management (Contractor) will continue utility relocation for the Union Square/Market Street area. This will require relocating all underground utilities from the street to underneath the sidewalks along Stockton Street.

Utility Relocation work on Stockton Street will be performed from January through approximately July 2012.

Here are some facts that you should be aware of:

Work Area: Along Stockton Street from Sutter to Market Street, including side streets on Sutter, Geary, Post, O'Farrell, Ellis, Market and Maiden Lane. One traffic lane on Stockton Street during construction hours will be limited to buses, taxis and delivery trucks only. Private passenger vehicles will be rerouted through the approved traffic reroute plan (see orange detour signs). Pedestrian traffic lanes will be created during work on sidewalks. The contractor will maintain pedestrian access to all businesses during business hours. Please expect an increase in noise, dust and traffic as a result of this construction.
