The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) and Synergy Project Management will continue utility relocation for the Moscone Station and Tunnel Portal. Utility relocation work on 4th and Stillman streets will continue from Dec. 19, 2011 through Jan. 2012.

Here are some facts that you should be aware of:

Work Area: At the intersection of 4th and Stillman streets between 3rd and 4th streets, sidewalks will be constructed for pedestrian traffic. The contractor will maintain safe pedestrian access to all businesses during business hours from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Please expect an increase in noise, dust and traffic as a result of this construction.
