The Central Subway will connect Chinatown and downtown with Muni and BART service at the Powell Street Station.

The Union Square shopping district and Westfield Mall are among many retail and business opportunities along the Central Subway.

In San Francisco's South of Market district, two stations will provide access to Moscone Center, Yerba Buena, and Brannan Street.

T Third trains will go down 4th Street to a stop near the Caltrain Station, which will also provide a nearby connection for AT&T Park.

The T Third Line is a valuable transit connection for the UCSF Mission Bay Campus, and the Potrero/Dogpatch neighborhoods.

City College of San Francisco's Evans campus is one of many important community institutions served by the T Third Line.

In Bayview/Hunters Point, the T Third Line is a critical piece of infrastructure for both residents and local employment opportunities.

The T Third Line provides Visitacion Valley with further connections to jobs and improved travel times over local busing.
